## Unmet Needs


- lack of Affordable housing options
- lack of Landlords who will accept Housing Vouchers
  - tenants with income support program types of income, Transportation, food, and Hygiene/Household products.
- Schools in Preble County reported large increases in numbers of students who were unable to pay for school lunch, as school lunch prices increased more than 400% from FY 22

## A Client Success Story received from Family Promise of Greene County Ohio

When Amara entered the shelter, she came in as a single mother of a young boy, Oliver. Amara had been staying with her daughter, but she decided it was time to give her son the home that he deserved. She had a passion for doing hair and that is what she did for a living. She was excited to start this new journey, although she knew it would be complicated, she was ready to tackle all of her obstacles. Amara was seeking shelter because she knew that it was time for her to take steps to bettering her future, not only for her, but for her child.



During her stay at Family Promise, she was able to obtain her cosmetology license, with the assistance from Family Promise. Amara also attended Parenting Classes, where she earned a certificate as well as Nutrition Classes which she also graduated from! Once she was able to get a job, she went to work at a local salon. Amara was able to obtain housing for her and her son and successfully complete the program.



## Meet Caitlyn

Caitlyn, a single mother of one, left an abusive relationship and got laid off her job. With finances tight due to her recent lay off, Caitlyn needed rental assistance. Caitlyn was able to call **HelpLink 2-1-1**, a 24-hour lifeline where you can talk to a free, confidential, and compassionate professional who will review your situation and connect you with resources to meet your needs.

Through **HelpLink 2-1-1** Caitlyn was referred to United Way of the Greater Dayton Area supported programs and received assistance with Utilities and Rent. Caitlyn was truly grateful for the assistance she received. She was blessed to be able to keep her family in their home.
